- Additionally, the issue based on Government flagship programme, such as: Digital India, Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana, Beti Bachao Beti Padhao, Skill India, Startup India, Namami Gange, Indradhanush (Immunization) & Ayushman Bharat, River & Soil conservation. Subject like- One Nation One Election, 'Jo Khelega Wo Kilega'- *Khel aur Fitness ka Mahatwa kya Bharat main jaroori Hai?*

Other details of the youth parliament, like Pre-Registration, screening, date and timings of the program shall be informed by the organising Colleges. Meanwhile kindly carry out college level Selection process as per the above guideline.
