Subject : Azadi Ka Amrut Mahotsav - Clean India Program from 1st to 31st October, 2021-reg.

Sir/Madam,

I am to refer to this office earlier communications on the subject cited above and to inform that Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, Govt. of India is organizing a Clean India Program from 1st to 31st October, 2021 as a part of the Azadi Ka Amrut Mahotsav. The main objective of this program is to organize activities to clean the waste – mainly single use Plastic Waste, cleaning of public places, cleanliness and maintenance of traditional water sources. In this connection, a virtual meeting was organized on 20/09/21, where the Hon'ble Minister of Youth Affairs & Sports, Government of India chaired the meeting along with District Commissioners of all Districts. Further, today a Planning meeting was organized to execute the activities on Clean India Program. Please find attached a Plan of Action prepared at Maharashtra & Goa State level in consultation with SNO.

As a part of this program, on 2nd October a Plogging run will be organized by NYKS and NSS and subsequently a month long cleaning drive will be carried out. The collection and disposal of plastic waste will be undertaken by the volunteers of NYK affiliated Youth clubs, NSS, NCC, Scouts and Guides and other community based organizations on voluntary basis with the support of District Administration, Government Agencies and Panchayat Raj Institutions.

You are requested to issue necessary directions to all the NSS Program Officers under your jurisdiction to take up this Clean India Program in a befitting manner, in their respective adopted villages. **The District Youth Officers of NYKS will be coordinating and they will contact the NSS District Nodal Officers.** Kindly instruct the NSS Programme Officers to provide necessary assistance to the NYKS District Youth Officers of your District for effective organization of this programme and direct them to submit a report along with action photographs of this program immediately after completion of each activity for onward transmission to the Ministry and uploading in the Ministry's Social media portals.
