As per the direction received from Asstt. Programme Advisor, NSS Regional Centre, Pune, Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, Government of India, it is to inform you that the following activities / programmes should undertake under the NSS Regular as well Special Camp programme.

- Promoting activities / programme for the promotion of welfare of the aged following activities / programmes for the promotion of welfare of the agrd may undertake in NSS.
 - NSS Unit can visit the old –age home nearby their institutions regularly and under take various welfare programmes for the inmates.
 - NSS units can form 'Voluntary clubs' of volunteers willing to help the aged people in emergencies like hospitalization and distress.
 - NSS unit can organize sensitization programmes for the students and community members on the need for taking care of the aged.
 - NSS units can prepare a directory of aged people in their adopted area and make periodical visits to the bed-ridden people apart from taking follow up of their medical/health needs.
 - Display of notices and bill-boards in the campuses and adopted area promoting the idea.
 - Collection of used old-age health care aricles like air-bed, walking/sitting aid form the public and distribution of the same to the needy.
 - Organisation of Health chech-up including cateract camps for the aged in collaboration with local public/private health centres and take follow up of the proper treatment.
 - NSS units can from "Voluntary Health Teams for the Aged" in collaboration with local hospital/doctor and arrange regular chech up of the poor bed-ridden patients at their residence/old age homes.
 - Collection of resources and donations from the public for the welfare/treatment of the aged among the very poor.
- **2. Youth for Employment Crises** programmes for the promotion of employment amoung the youth.
 - Organisation of sensitization programmes for the students as well as community members on topics of promotion of employment and employability of youth.
 - Organision of programmes for the development of communication skills of the youth so as to enablethem to meet the challenging requirements in public and private sector employmentnationally and internationally.
 - Dissemination of information on various schemes for the promotion of self employment.
 - Organisation of workshops/seminars/group discussionjs ect. In collaboration with various agencies working in the field for development of knowledge on employment generation among the youth.
