10th **Aug 2013** - SPOC Team to confirm to conduct the event in their respective Colleges in 3 days during the week 11th to 17th August 2013.

Campaign Guidelines to the SPOC Team of the College

- SPOC Team to display notice in all the notice boards in the campus regarding the campaign and create requisite awareness among the students on the importance of this drive.
- SPOC Team to provide the list of students having Voters Registration Card along with their Photostat copies as per administrative wards of MMR to verify as per the existing rolls.
- MVMH Volunteers shall only assist the college in the process, but the actual event to be conducted by college itself with their students among their students.
- SPOC Team to reserve seminar room with required facility during the campaign.
- SPOC Team to actively encourage students to participate in this campaign for registering students of other colleges through College Extra Curricular Cell.
- Each college shall be evaluated /graded on the basis of Number of students enrolled and Number of students with valid names in the electoral rolls. This will be displayed on CEO, MH Website.
