As you are aware, University of Mumbai has introduced the new pattern of examination – Semester and Grading System from the last year. This system require to submit the assignments by each student for each semester for all the subjects.

You are requested to guide / communicate the concerned teacher of respective subjects to assign the NSS Projects base assignment and considered that assignment as a part of new semester pattern examination.
