This is to inform you that, the NSS Cell, University of Mumbai have received a circular from Youth Officer & Head, NSS Regional Centre, Pune, Government of India regarding National Road Safety Week to observe from 11th to 17th January 2015.

The NSS Unit is already undertaking various activities for the Road Safety Campaign.

Tentative list of the activities that can be undertaken as a part of National Road Safety Week – 11th to 17th January 2015.

Theme for National Road Safety Week – “Safety is not just a slogan, It’s a way of life”

1. To observe the rules of road regulation – 1989. The week- long activities could help motivate and rededicate all towards this end.
2. Display of Flex banner, poster at entry/exit of the building, parking lots etc. Notifying the week and displaying the theme.
3. Workshops, discussions, essay competition, Quiz contest etc. On the issue related to road safety i.e. efforts of violation of road safety rules, rules of road regulation-1989 and other Motor Vehicle regulation.
4. Organisation of medical camps for check-up/camps of drives.
5. Organizing Cyclothon/ Walkthon to create awareness among the citizens about the major risk factor for accidents viz over speeding, drunken driving etc.
6. Organise refresher training programmes for all drivers by imparting training about road safety rules, various sign/signages and first aid service in case of accident.
7. Spreading information about the Supreme Court’s directives that the effort to save all accident victims should be the top priority not only of the medical professional but even of all the police or any other citizen who happens to be connected with that or who happens to notice witness an incident
8. Fitness check-up of all the Government vehicles
9. Under CSR Rules, 2014, PSUs can undertake Road Safety Activities as a part of their CSR activities.

You are requested to conduct the above Road Safety activities in your College, adopted area & nearby area of your College and kindly send the report on the above after completion of the programme.
