Lymphatic filariasis (LF) known as elephantiasis (Haatipaon), is a serious debilitating disease transmitted through the bite of Culex mosquitos which breeds in dirty/polluted water. Infection is usually acquired in childhood causing damage to the lymphatic system. The painful and profoundly disfiguring visible manifestations of the disease, lymphoedema, and scrotal swelling occur later in life and can lead to permanent disability. India alone accounts for approximately 55 % of the global burden of LF. The disease is endemic in 20 States/UTs of India. Approximately 740 million population in 336 districts of these states/UTs are at risk of LF.

LF is a priority disease for Government of the India and is targeted for elimination by 2027. As a new Strategy, Mass Drug Administration (MDA) will be conducted in a mission mode twice a year on 10<sup>th</sup> February and 10<sup>th</sup> August along with National Deworming Day (NDD). The Phase 2 MDA Campaign is scheduled from 10th August 2023 in 82 districts of eight states: Assam, Bihar, Uttar Pradesh, Jharkhand, Odisha, Chhattisgarh, Maharashtra, and Telangana (Annexure 1).

The new strategy demands synergy of efforts by all the departments and culminates into a "Jan Andolan" for improved compliance of MDA. The roles and responsibilities envisaged for successful MDA campaigns for various departments are attached (Annexure 2).

The support of the Ministry of Youth is pivotal for the successful implementation of the August 2023 MDA particularly with the support of NSS volunteers, and thus it is important to communicate to your Regional Directors and State Nodal Officials of the mentioned State and organize a virtual review meeting with them in this regard at the earliest opportunity preferably by 10<sup>th</sup> July 2023.

Hon'ble Member Niti Aayog will also conduct a review meeting with all allied ministries tentatively during 1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nd</sup> week of July for soliciting their support in the upcoming August MDA.
