In continuation with this office earlier Communication / emails & messages on the subject, it is to inform that as per the directions of Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports, Government of India, New Delhi, All College NSS Units / Programme Officers are hereby requested to ensure organisation of Meri Mati Mera Desh Programme at the Grampanchayat / locality (Institution) on 9<sup>th</sup> to 15<sup>th</sup> August, 2023.

Kindly expedite the Registration of NSS Volunteers in MMMD Portal - <a href="https://nsf.yas.gov.in/nss">https://nsf.yas.gov.in/nss</a>. After registration of NSS PO Link for volunteers registration will be generated in which registration of volunteers / details of volunteers to be added. Preparatory meeting shall be organized by the NSS unit of every Institution with Grampanchayat & the minutes of the meeting in the enclosed Performa to be sent to NSSRD Pune.

Detailed guidelines for Meri Maati Mera Desh program received from the Directorate of NSS, New Delhi is attached.

<u>Programmes under Meri Maati Mera Desh to be organised in the Institution</u> along with Rural and Urban Areas are given below.

<u>A.</u> Programs in Rural Areas: There are three key stages to the programme in the rural areas -Panchayat/village/Institution level programme, Block level program and the finale at the national level.

- i) Institution/Panchayat level programs: These programs to be organized between 9<sup>th</sup> to 15<sup>th</sup> August, 2023. NSS Volunteers will assist the NYKS at Panchayat level. There are five elements of the panchayat level programmes.
- <u>a) Dedication of Shilaphalakam (Memorial)</u> -A Fundamental aspect of the program is to express heartfelt gratitude to all the brave hearts (Veer) who made supreme sacrifice. Event may be held at the panchayat / Village from 9<sup>th</sup> August to 15<sup>th</sup> August, 2023.
- b) Panch Pran Pledge At the memorial site; people will take a solemn pledge covering Panch Pran of the Hon'ble Prime Minister, affirming their commitment to the country. Pledge given in the enclose guidelines. During the ceremony NSS Volunteers / Programme officer / Public would either individually or collectively take a Selfie while taking pledge with the soil in hand and upload to the dedicated website.

- c) Vasudha vandhan: Each Gram panchayat / village/ Institution will renew and replenish Mother Earth by planting 75 saplings of Indigenous species and developing an Amrit vatika.
- d) Veeron ka Vandan: All NSS Units may hold felicitation ceremonies at institutions level for honoring freedom fighters and the families of the deceased freedom fighters. They may also honor retired personnel from Defence, CRPF and state Police and the families of brave hearts of these forces who have sacrificed their lives in the line of duty. Felicitation may be as per local traditions and customs
- e) Hoisting of the national Flag and singing of Rashtragaan may be undertaken at each of the programme's sites.
- ii) Block level programs/Institutions: NSS Volunteers would extend support to NYKS volunteers in respective districts to collect Mitti from each panchayat/village and bring them to the block level.
- iii) Finale Event at New Delhi will be held from 27<sup>th</sup> August to 30<sup>th</sup> August,2023.

## B. Programs in Urban areas

- i) <u>Programmes in Universities/Colleges/Institutions/small urban bodies/Town panchayat will be organised from 9<sup>th</sup> to 15<sup>th</sup> August,2023. All five elements detailed for the Rural areas above.</u>
- ii) programmes at the larger Municipalities/Corporations.
- iii) Finale Event at New Delhi from 27<sup>th</sup> to 30<sup>th</sup> August, 2023.
