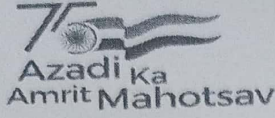

Dear Sir / Madam,

With reference to the above subject cited above and to inform that, the Ministry of Home Affairs has launched the Indian Cyber Crime Coordination Centre (14C) to strengthen the capacities of law Enforcement Agencies (LEAs) and to improve coordination among the LEAs and other agencies.

Therefore, it has been decided by Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports and Ministry of Home Affairs to observe the "Cyber Jaagrookta (Awareness) Diwas (CJD)" on the first Wednesday of every month in all the Colleges / Institutions.

In this regards, following have been proposed in respect of participation of NSS Volunteers/Po's for better coordination and implementation of schemes related to cyber crime:-

- Training of NSS Volunteers/POs on Cyber Crime Prevention/ Control procedure/ Policies.
- Recognition/ Registration of NSS Volunteers as Cyber volunteers.
- Universities/ Colleges and NSS Volunteers may form the Cyber Clubs in their respective Universities / Colleges.
- National Cyber Crime Training Centre has CyTrain Portal in which Cyber Crime related material course is available as well as courses on iGOT portal
- Universities / Colleges may organize some contests based on cyber hygiene, like Cyber Olympiad etc. annually.
- For Dissemination of Cyber Hygiene messages, Universities/ Colleges may award best Professor/ Teacher/ NSS Volunteers during their Annual Functions.

In this regard all College NSS Units / Programme Officers are requested to ensure participation of all the NSS Programme Officer/ Volunteers in observance of "Cyber Jaagrookta (Awareness) Diwas (CJD)" on the first Wednesday of every month in all the Schools/Colleges/ Universities and report & photos of activity may be sent undersign, State NSS Cell and for onward submission to the Ministry.
