Details of the Street Play Competitions: -

1. Street Play Competition: (For the students of Degree College)

Rules for the Street Play Competition:

1. No entry fees but registration is mandatory.

2. The competition is for the students of Degree College.

3. A participating team will present a street play pertaining to only one of the topics.

4. The minimum and maximum no. of students in a team should be 8 and 10 respectively.

5. The maximum duration of the Street Play should be 10 minutes. First warning bell will be given after 8 minutes and final warning bell after 10 minutes. The marks will be deducted if the play exceeds the time limit.

6. If props are required, the team is supposed to manage them. The host will not make any provisions for the props. Teams should remove all the props and set items if used any after the performance.

7. The play will be performed on an open ground without any sound/ music system. Teams can sing/dance by themselves to create the necessary music or sound.

8. Use of electric/ electronic devices is not permissible.

9. The organisers and judges' decision will be final.

10. The participating teams must observe proper decency and decorum in the attire, performance and general behaviour. Use of abusive language and/or indecent behaviour will lead to disqualification of the team.

11. The street play can be in Hindi, Marathi or English (or a mixture of these).

12. All the participants must carry a valid ID Card issued by their institution.

13. All participants must report at the venue at least one hour prior to the commencement of the event.

14. Date of the Competition: 10th December 2024, Reporting Time: 10.00 am

15. Venue of the competition: B. K. Birla College, Kalyan

16. Last date of Registration is 25th November 2024

17. The best team will present their street play at the National Conference on 1st **February 2025** at University of Mumbai, Kalina Campus.
