Key Activities of the Program:

- Collection & disposal of waste through cleanliness and collection drives and door to door campaign.
- Village Beautification- Maintenance and beautification drives for historical monuments and heritage sites, Community Centres, Youth Club/Mahila Mandal Buildings, School Buildings, Panchyat Buildings etc.
- Cleanliness in coastal area at 02nd October, 2024 " aimed at cleanliness of beaches and addressing the problem of single use plastic wastes in coastal areas shall be undertaken across the country.
